



## TECHNICAL REPORT FOR THE FESTIVAL TEAM

# CAR WASH

**Duration: approx. 40 minutes // Audience: all ages**

### Sound system

*Car Wash* is a show that is **fully autonomous in terms of sound system and electrical power.**

In the case of a very large space or a particularly large audience, it may be useful to connect the artist's equipment to a sound system provided by the organizers.

In this case, organizers are invited to provide:

- a sound system to complement the artist's own equipment,
- **access to a power outlet before the show** in order to recharge the devices,
- a 6.35 mm jack cable (large jack).

**Set-up / dismantling: 10 minutes**

### Road

- **Vehicle / caravan:** Camper Fiat Ducato DV223JB
- **Dimensions:** 8 m long, 2.3 m wide, 2.80 m high

### In case of air travel

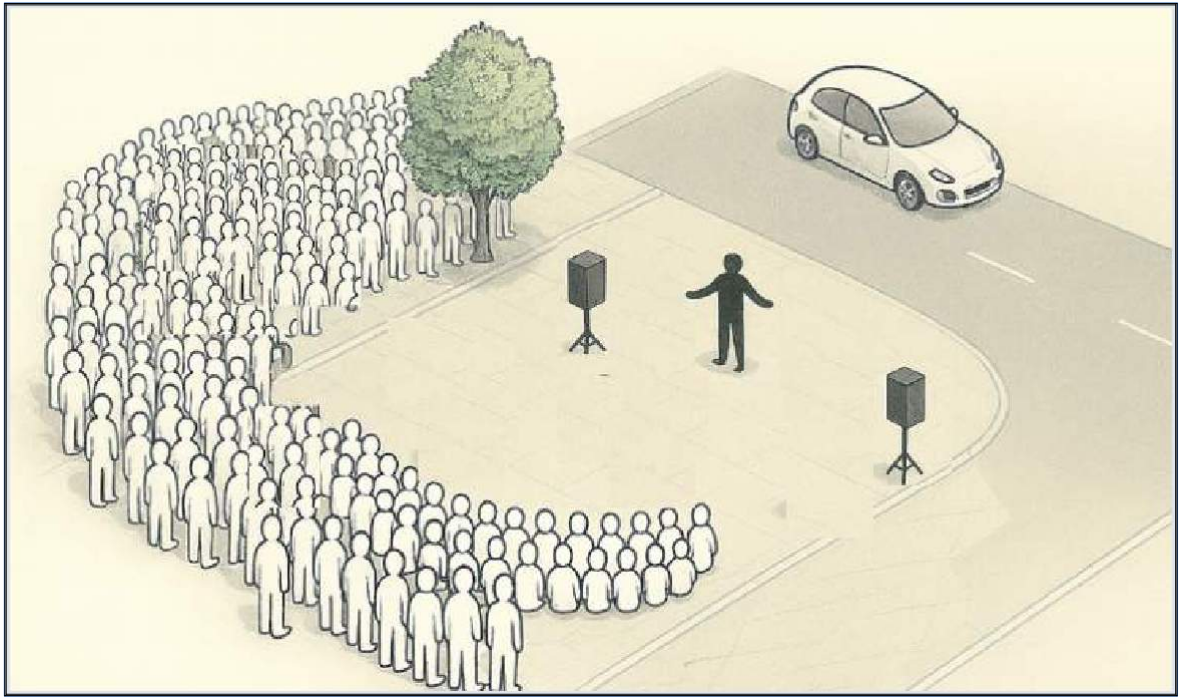
- One 10 kg carry-on cabin luggage
- One 20 kg checked luggage (approx. 70 cm x 50 cm x 30 cm)

### Scenography

A sponge, water and soap  
Pressurized water spray  
Plastic buckets  
Costumes for volunteers (giant brushes)

### **Performance space**

**Ideal:** a square, promenade, street, avenue or roundabout. Car traffic must be moderate and occasional so as not to cause traffic issues.

*Obviously, public safety is fundamental. For this reason, there must be a reserved safe area from which the show is visible and that allows the artist to interact with the audience.*

### **Safety:**

At least two volunteers are required to monitor the audience during the show. The artist himself remains constantly attentive and vigilant to everything happening around the performance area.

**ImproWash** is the version of *Car Wash* without car traffic.

It was presented this year, in 2025, in Aurillac.

The show follows the same storyline as *Improlocura*, with a finale that recalls *Car Wash*.
